

4-H CLUB AWARDS

Banner Club of the Month Award

Clubs can compete for the Banner Club of the Month Award by earning as many points as possible during each club meeting. At the end of the month, the clubs in each grade division with the most points will win free coupons from local restaurants.

The following is used to determine the MONTHLY BANNER CLUB SCORES:

- 1. Performance of Officers** 0 – 20 points
Each officer is worth 5 points.
- 2. Parliamentary Procedure** followed 0 – 10 points
- 3. Program** 0 – 15 points
American & 4-H pledges and Thought for the Day
- 4. Conduct of Members** 0 – 25 points
- 5. Contest Participation** 0 – 35 points
Each member that participates in a contest earns points for their club.
- 6. Extra Credit** 0 – 10 points
This includes a poem, demonstration, skit, special singing, talent, etc. Extra credit should **always** be prepared for each club meeting even when time will be limited.
- 7. Service Project** 0 – 20 points
Service projects done **jointly as a club** (must submit service project form)
- 8. Bonus Points** 5 - 20 points
If club members participate on a judging team, chick chain, or compete in county or regional contest, 5 points will be added per 4-H'er with a maximum of 20 points.

POSSIBLE FINAL SCORE

155 points

100% Public Speaking Plaques

Clubs with 100% participation in the November speech contest will receive a plaque to display in their classroom.
