Campers should arrive in the parking lot of Smith County Middle School no later than 7:15 a.m. to get ready to depart for camp.

All campers will need to fill out a COVID-19 health screening form before they get on the bus. Masks will be required in situations where social distancing isn't possible. 4-H neck gaiters will be provided to all campers.

The day's activities will include ziplining, kayaking, swimming, archery/rifle range, tie-dying t-shirts, and leathercraft.

Campers are encouraged to wear comfortable clothes and tennis shoes.

A hotdog lunch and chicken strip dinner will be provided for all campers.

What to Bring to Camp:

- Swimsuit
- Beach Towel
- Swim Accessories (goggles, earplugs, etc.)
- Money for canteen & gift shop (optional, \$20 or less suggested)
